The bikes are designed to perform at their best in everyday road conditions, so the suspension is compliant, stability paramount and the riding positions are as friendly in town as they are at high speeds.

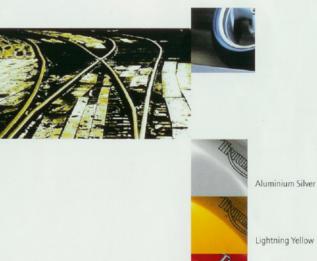


More refinements and sharper steering for Triumph's exhilarating flagship supersports machine.

The 955i has established itself as the epitome of high performance real-world road bikes with its breathtaking acceleration, astonishing smoothness and flexibility, secure and accurate handling and class-leading brakes.

Now it turns even quicker and looks better than ever: the wheelbase is a full 15mm shorter for rapid, precise handling, while a number of detail changes have given the Daytona a more aggressive, purposeful look. The revised graphics are sportier and more dramatic, while the new circular-section, brushed metal silencer shows off even more of the gun metal silver rear wheel.

The essential appeal of the 955i remains undiluted – modern classic British superbike style centred around a unique, tubular aluminium trellis frame, everyday usability, and of course blistering performance.

Brand new for the year 2000, the Sprint RS is a light, lean sports bike.

The Sprint RS is aimed at the rider who likes to see the heart of his machine.

The slim, efficient fairing boldly exposes the RS engine, which is based on the Sprint ST's definitive fuel-injected, three-cylinder unit but finished in graphite grey to enhance its muscular appearance.

But it doesn't just look potent – the forceful 112PS maximum horsepower is backed up by a wide spread of torque which peaks at 72 ft-lb.

Impressive – and when you add the alluring character and response unique to Triumph's three cylinder engines, quite irresistible.

To make the most of the motor, the agile Sprint RS is designed to take on the most demanding back roads, its precision handling ensured by the rigid, black-finished twin spar aluminium frame and high quality suspension.

A fine all-rounder, certainly, but with the focus on fun and excitement.



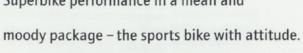

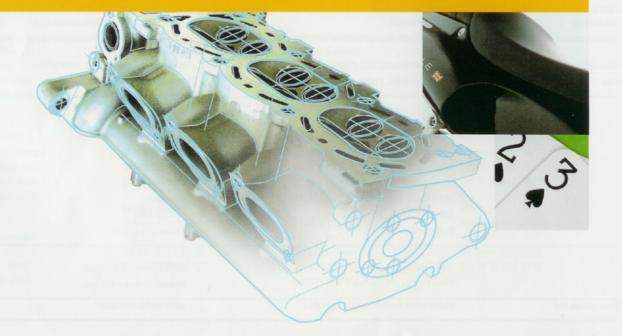

The daring Speed Triple is the most radical bike ever built by Triumph, displaying all the naked aggression of a stripped down streetfighter.

The styling's uncompromised and so is the engineering, as the Speed Triple shares its major components with the supersports Daytona. Which means a rigid, tubular aluminium trellis frame with state-of-the-art single-sided swinging arm, high quality suspension front and rear, eye-popping brakes and the 955cc fuel-injected, three cylinder motor that's won so much praise, tuned for a broader spread of torque.

This is the wild side of sports bike riding, emphasised by the new and more aggressive graphics.

Arresting looks, with the muscle to back them up.

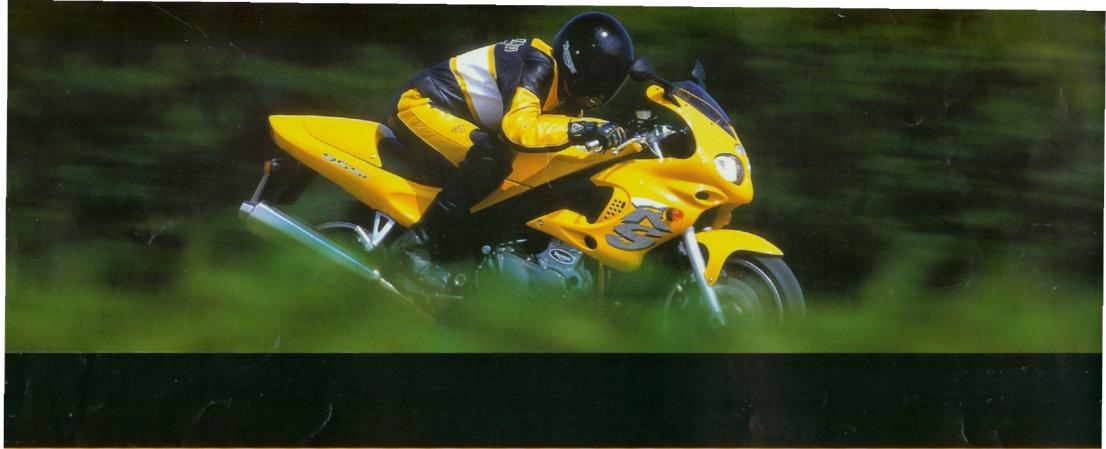
